

## **Olympus 16 Camera Setup Instructions**


**IMPORTANT**: Set camera setting to shoot in raw and turn on white correction settings.




- 1. Place four AA batteries appropriately into strobe.
- 2. Press case door down firmly.



- 3. Twist dial to the right so that the arrows point toward each other.
  - This locks the battery case.
- 4. Turn small lower dial to TTL when in use.




- 5. Make sure arm is attached to strobe.
  - Twist on attachment screw firmly.



- 6. Make sure the arm mount is firmly screwed into the camera case with both screws.
- 7. Orient strobe above the camera when in use.



- 8. Plug one end of the optic cable into the strobe.
- 9. Plug the other end of the optic cable into the case port.
  - Wrap cable around the arm so that it will not get in the way.



- 10. Take strobe over off.
- 11. Place moisture-removing packet into case along with camera.
